## LARRY CHASE

Larry Chase began his career at Huset's Speedway in 1960 as a crew member on a car driven by Harlan Ter Wee and owned by Harlan's brother, Harry. After Harlan Ter Wee's death in a plane crash in 1963, the car was driven for a year by Hall of Fame member Marv DeWall. The following season, Chase took his turn behind the wheel, driving the Ter Wee "Deuce" for the next four years. After his stint as a driver, Chase became a spectator for several years before promoter and Hall of Famer Fred Buckmiller asked him to be the head flagman. Chase obliged, flagging the races for the next 10 years before eventually stepping down and giving control over the race track to current flagman Doug Clark.
